



INTRODUCTION

The Specialty Equipment Market Association, as part of its role of supporting the many voters who make up the U.S. automotive aftermarket industry, is providing non-partisan information on the major-party candidates who are running for federal office in 2024. Our experts in Washington, D.C., see firsthand how the decisions made in Congress and the halls of state capitols can have a lasting impact on not only SEMA members, but also the specialty equipment industry and auto enthusiasts, and advocate for policy issues that are core to SEMA's mission by ensuring policymakers hear a clear, strong, and unified voice from those impacted the most by their decisions.



ABOUT THIS GUIDE

This Voter Guide is intended as a resource for prospective voters so that they may be armed with the knowlege of which candidates best represent their values as they pertain to the automotive aftermarket. Each candidate is evaluated based on their positions on a series of recent legislation in the U.S. House of Representatives.

A 'YES' vote means the lawmaker was in support of SEMA's position on that particular bill.

Conversely, a 'NO' vote indicates opposition to SEMA's stance.

Please note that not all bills make it to the House floor for a vote. As this was the case for two pieces of SEMA-supported legislation: the EXPLORE Act and the REPAIR Act, e provided a checkmark besides the names of lawmakers who co-sponsored these two bills. A check mark means that even though the legislation didn't make it for a full vote, these lawmakers publicly supported the bills as sponsors.




BILLS OF NOTE

The U.S. House of Representatives is made up of 435 members each serving two-year terms. Every seat in the House is up for vote in 2024. The Republicans currently hold a 220 to 212 majority in the House (there are three vacancies). The following bills represent the most important pieces of legislation for the automotive aftermarket industry, including four bills already voted on by the House:

Preserving Choice in Vehicle Purchases Act (<u>H.R. 1435</u>) prohibits the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) from allowing California to implement its Advance Clean Cars II (ACC II) regulation that prohibits the sale of new internal combustion engine (ICE) vehicles starting in 2035 and mandates that all new vehicles must be zero-emission vehicles (ZEV). House vote: 222-190 (214 Republicans & 8 Democrats voted for the bill)

Choice in Automobile Retail Sales Act (CARS Act) (<u>H.R. 4468</u>) would stop the EPA's tailpipe emissions rulemaking for model-year 2027 to 2032 light and medium-duty motor vehicles, which requires up to 83% of all new vehicles sold in 2032 to be ZEV. The bill also prohibits the EPA from implementing future regulations to mandate the use of any specific vehicle technology. House vote: 221-197 (216 Republicans & 5 Democrats voted for the bill)

Western Economic Security Today Act (WEST Act) (<u>H.R. 3397</u>) would stop the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) from implementing its conservation rulemaking that could lock up public lands under new and vaguely defined conservation leases. House vote: 212-202 (209 Republicans & 3 Democrats voted for the bill)



BILLS OF NOTE (CONT.)

Tax Relief for American Families and Workers Act (<u>H.R.7024</u>) allows for immediate expensing of research and development (R&D) investments, interest deductibility, and the restoration of full and immediate expensing for investments in machines, equipment, and vehicles with the cap for small businesses increased from \$1 million to \$1.29 million. House vote: 357 to 70 (169 Republicans & 188 Democrats voted for the bill)

Right to Equitable and Professional Auto Industry Repair Act (REPAIR Act) (<u>H.R. 906</u>) prohibits automakers from imposing technological or legal barriers that block aftermarket replacement part manufacturers from accessing critical information and tools necessary to develop interoperable products with emerging vehicle technology. The bill requires OEMs to make any repair information and tools available to replacement part manufacturers and repair facilities at a fair and reasonable cost. It also ensures that vehicle owners and the automotive repair business of their choice have access to wirelessly transmitted vehicle data that only OEMs and their authorized dealers have access to currently. No vote; 56 cosponsors (28 Republicans & 28 Democrats)

Expanding Public Lands Outdoor Recreation Experiences Act (EXPLORE Act) (<u>H.R. 6492</u>) is a bipartisan bill that streamlines the process and expenses associated with obtaining special recreation permits, requires federal land management agencies to increase opportunities for motorized and non-motorized access on public lands, and directs the BLM and Forest Service to make maps available to the public depicting where vehicles are allowed to recreate.

Passed House via voice vote; 51 cosponsors (24 Republicans & 27 Democrats)
