# About the Event

## What is the Women's Leadership Forum?

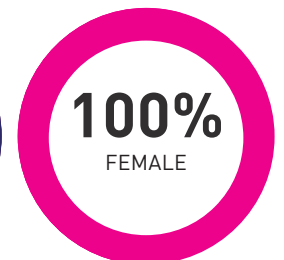
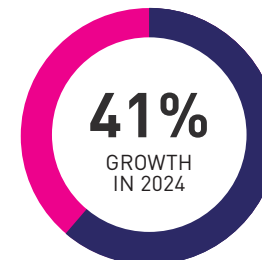
## What happens at the event?

The event hosts 2 days of educational sessions. The education formats range from keynote speakers, panel discussions, deep dive sessions, and break out discussions. The program includes many formal and informal networking sessions geared towards providing quality time for attendees to talk about both professional and personal goals as well as creating valuable industry connections that can benefit their companies. The event hosts breakfasts, lunches and a themed dinner to create those much needed brain breaks for attendees.



## Who attends?

The Women's Leadership Forum attracts a broad range of women from the aftermarket industry. In the past three years, the registration has continued to grow for each event. In 2024, the registration grew 41%, including 53 registrants who had not attended the event in the past. Registrants are from all areas of the aftermarket and in different roles such as, c-suite, mid-management and entry-level. This dynamic in-person event has a maximum registration of 100 females. This limit provides an intimate environment for networking with a wide range of professionals.



## Why should I sponsor?
